## How to Teach this Book

The aim of teaching the ABC book is that learners should know each letter's name and sound and how to write it. It is not required that the learner be able to read and spell each word in the book.

## 1) Search for the letter

- Introduce the new letter by name and sound. Write it on the blackboard and point it out in the book.
- Ask the learners what the first picture on the page is.
- Write the word on the blackboard and tell them what it says.
- Ask if someone can point to the new letter in that word.
- Repeat steps 2-4 for the other 2 pictures.

2) Listen to the sound of the letter

- Tell the learners to listen for the sound of the new letter as you read the 3 words. Stress the new letter. Read them again. Get them to repeat the sound.
- Ask them to name other words that have the same sound (at the beginning of the word if possible).


## 3) Writing

- On the blackboard, point to the letter with your hand. Write it again and explain what you are doing.
- Teach the students to write the letter in the air. Make sure you stand with your back to them as you write in the air. Let them copy you.
- Get the learners to write two rows of the letter in their exercise books.

4) Revise the Letter

- Point to the letter on the blackboard.
- Ask the learners the name and sound of the letter.
